

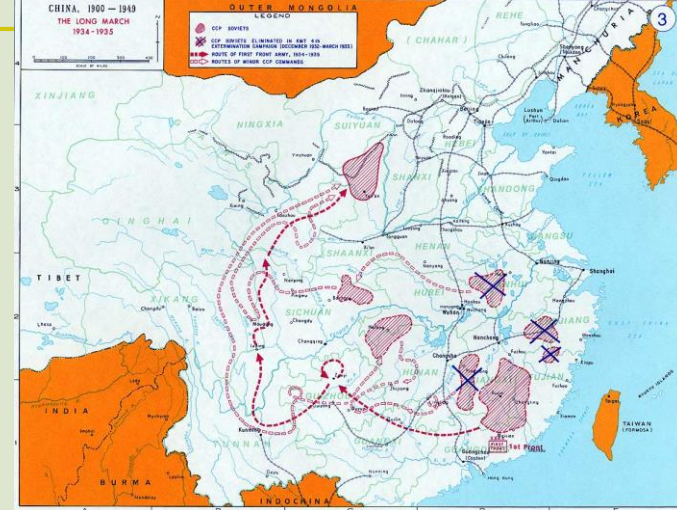
CCP

 - 1949 – Tiananmen Square “the Chinese people have stood up”

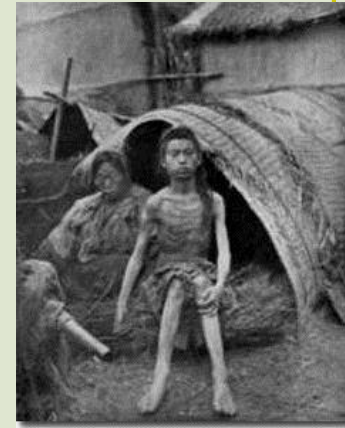
• 5-Year Plans and failure

• Great Leap Forward: 1958 – 1960

- Small-scale industrialization in rural areas / people's communes
- Between '59 and '62, 20 million starve

• The Great Cultural Revolution: 1966 - 69

- To combat capitalist infiltration / Red Guard
- Mao's efforts failed in “eliminating differences between classes, between urban and rural life, and between men and women”



CCP

- Mao dies in 1976
 - Like de-Stalinization efforts in USSR
- Deng Xiaoping – Capitalism restored by the Communist Party (wait, what?)
 - Dismantled collective agriculture, released prisoners, relaxed censorship, welcomed foreign investment
 - Ridiculously successful economy, but...Immense environmental damages...and corruption
 - Brutally crushed student protests in '89
- Xi Jinping and China Today
